

College of Veterinary Science was established on 05.08.1946 as a constituent College of Osmania University by His Excellency, the Nizam of Hyderabad, a Princely state in the pre-independent India. Later became a part of Andhra Pradesh Agricultural University until 2005. In the year 2005, Veterinary faculty was delineated from the Agricultural University and a separate University was formed in the name of Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University (SVVU), Tirupati. Consequent to the bifurcation of Andhra Pradesh state as Andhra Pradesh and Telangana states in the year 2014, Sri P. V. Narasimha Rao Telangana State University for Veterinary, Animal and Fishery Sciences was established by the Government of Telangana on 22.11.2014 with headquarters at Rajendranagar, Hyderabad. Subsequently, the University was renamed as P. V. Narsimha Rao Telangana Veterinary University (PVNRTVU) from 24.05.2016. The University covers entire Telangana state with 3 Veterinary Colleges, 1 Dairy Technology College, 1 Fishery Science College and 4 Animal Husbandry Polytechnic Colleges, 4 Research Institutes, 1 Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK) and 1 Electron Microscope Laboratory (Ruska Labs).



About Venue

Hyderabad, the capital of Telangana State, is the historical place of Kakatiya, Qutub Shahi and Nizam rulers having 400 years of history along with twin city Secunderabad is located on the banks of the river Musi. Hyderabad weather in the month of November is cool and nice with temperature ranges from 17–31°C. Hyderabad is centre for several renowned Life Sciences R&D institutes of National and International repute, particularly in agriculture, molecular biology, forensic sciences and defense research laboratories and also a fast growing IT hub. The city is often known by the sobriquet “The City of Pearls”. The city is a regular tourist hotspot like Charminar, Golconda Fort, Salarjung Museum, Mecca Masjid, Qutub Shahi Tombs, Taj-Falaknuma Palace, Ramoji Film City etc.



The venue of the conference will be the majestic University Auditorium of Professor Jayashankar Telangana State Agricultural University (PJTSAU), located at Rajendranagar, Hyderabad (20 Km from Airport, 15 Km from Railway Station and 8 Km from Central Bus Station). The Auditorium, designed with 950 seater main hall, 2 mini seminar halls of 100 capacity each, besides sprawling lounges, waiting halls, dining area and state of the art audiovisual systems.





Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists (IAVP)

IAVP was founded in March, 1974 during a scientific get-together of Veterinary Pathologists at the Indian Veterinary Research Institute (IVRI), Izatnagar, UP, India. At the time of Green Revolution, emphasis was on expansion of agricultural education, almost simultaneously the scientists in field of Veterinary and Animal Husbandry faced challenge on the front of increasing demands for livestock and poultry production. In this connection, the assembly of the pathologists in the form of annual conventions and symposia on the current problems in Veterinary Science was first held at Veterinary College, Bengaluru in 1983 but became an annual features only after 1986.

Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists (ICVP)

ICVP was established in 2008 under the aegis of Indian Society for Certification of Veterinary Pathologists as an independent certification organization for personal accreditation in India. It aims for the advancements for Veterinary Pathology and its sub-specializations including Clinical Pathology, Avian Pathology, Aquatic Animal Pathology, Toxicopathology, Laboratory Animal Pathology etc., by establishing standards of training and experience. The organization was pioneered, conceived and developed by a group of 22 life members of the Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists having recognizable stature in academia, research industry and practice, identified as Charter Members.
