CITATION FOR AWARD OF THE IAVP FELLOWSHIP, 2022

Prof. Natesan Pazhanivel (52), born on June 3, 1971, in Variyankaval, a former district of Trichy, Tamil Nadu to Mr A.P. Natesan and Mrs N. Visalatchi. He pursued his BVSc degree, at Veterinary College and Research Institute, Namakkal followed by MVSc degree in Veterinary Pathology, at the same institute and obtained his PhD degree from Madras Veterinary College, Chennai. Beginning as a Research Associate at Madras Veterinary College, he later earned the MA in Public Administration from Madras University and a Postgraduate Diploma in Ethno-Veterinary Practices from TANUVAS. He passed Diplomate of Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists (DICVP) in 2010. He embarked on his academic journey as an Assistant Professor at the Veterinary University Training and Research Centre, Dharmapuri and currently serving as a Professor in Department of Veterinary Pathology, Madras Veterinary College, Chennai, Tamil Nadu.

He has guided one PhD and five MVSc students in discipline of Veterinary Pathology. He has served as a member of Advisory Committee for three MVSc and eight PhD students. He assisted two PG Diploma candidates. In addition to Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, he has also served as an external guide to the students of other Universities. He has published 312 research articles in National and International journals and presented 314 research papers at International and National Conferences. He authored 64 popular articles. In 2010, he was awarded the Fellow of the Academy of Sciences for Animal Welfare. In 2019, the Indian Council of Medical Research awarded him an ICMR-DHR-International Fellow. A total of 54 awards were conferred on him; these included the Outstanding Research Faculty in the Veterinary Discipline, Top 10 Knowledge Producers in India, IAVP-Dr B.L. Purohit Memorial Best Toxico-Pathologist Award, IAVP-Best Wildlife Pathologists Award, IAVP Achievement Award for the Best Poultry Pathologist, IAVP Achievement Award for the Best Companion Animal Pathologist, Eminent Veterinarian Award, 2023, Bharat Jyoti Award and the IAVP-Gang Mana Sharma Award for best article on pack animal.

He produced two documentary CD's and developed one e-content. He developed a mobile app titled "Diagnosis of dermatological conditions of dogs". He published 4 books and 55 book chapters. He has completed 6 projects and currently 3 projects are in progress. He completed Post-Doctoral Fellowship Research Training for 5½ months at Penn State University, USA. He delivered seven Radio talks and two TV talks for the benefit of farmers. He has organized one National Workshop, one National Conference and one online International Seminar. He acted as Co-Organizing Secretary for four Workshops and Training Programs. He served as Chairman and Committee Member to 21 training, seminar and symposium programs. He acted as a Committee Member in two International Conferences and Seminars. He attended 48 National and 46 International Conferences, Symposiums and Workshops. He attended 10 National and 5 International training programmes. He prepared 47 practical and training manuals. He presented five lead papers and delivered 45 guest lectures. He served as an Editorial Board Member of 7 journals. He is a member of 17 Professional Societies. He published five leaflets and folders. He has completed educational training for 14 days at Liverpool University, United Kingdom. From 2020 to 2022, he served as Secretary of the Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists. From the year 2023, he is serving as the Registrar of the Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists. He has been the Editor of, the Indian Veterinary Journal since 2022. He is also the Associate Editor of the Journal of Immunology and Immunopathology.

The Association confers fellowship and the title of Fellow of Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists (FIAVP) on Dr. Natesan Pazhanivel for his outstanding contributions to the advancement of Veterinary pathology.
