## About the Venue: SKUAST-Jammu

Sher-e-Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology of Jammu ([www.skuast.org](http://www.skuast.org)) came into existence on 20<sup>th</sup> September, 1999. The establishment of SKUAST of Jammu was instrumental to cater to the needs of Jammu Division for the region-specific advances through education, research and extension in the field of agriculture and allied sciences.

The multi-campus University comprises of many Faculties, including that of Agriculture, Horticulture and Forestry, Agricultural Engineering, Basic Sciences and Institute of Biotechnology situated in main campus Chatha; and the Faculties of Veterinary Sciences & Animal Husbandry, Dairy Technology at Ranbir Singh Pura Campus. Besides there are 9 different Research Stations and Sub-Stations, 10 AICRPs and 9 Krishi Vigyan Kendras.

The Faculty of Veterinary Sciences and Animal Husbandry (FVSc & AH) is ~10 km from SKUAST-Jammu, Chatha Main Campus. FVSc & AH came into existence on 15<sup>th</sup> December, 1995 when it was formally inaugurated by the then Governor of Jammu & Kashmir, Gen. (Retd.) K.V. Krishna Rao. The fledgling institute became the regional hub of veterinary education under the erstwhile SKUAST and then later under SKUAST-Jammu. The Faculty caters to the welfare of animal wealth and livestock farmers of the Jammu. The institute proudly

features a resourceful and diverse scientific workforce coming from various parts of the country. This amalgamated representation has enabled the faculty to intermingle diverse and liberal ideas through a unified scientific temperament.

### Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists and Golden Jubilee

In an epoch-making moment, an assemblage of renowned pathologist of that time met during a convention at IVRI, Bareilly. These pioneering visionaries conceptualized and established the Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists (IAVP) in March 1974 under the aegis of the founding President Prof. S. Damodaran. Today IAVP is a big fraternity, with a membership of about 1500 extant life-members, and still counting. The society aspired to accommodate all Veterinary Pathologists under one affiliation; deliberate and excogitate on animal diseases, their diagnosis, and most importantly amalgamate current updates in pathology. Continuing with its ambitious objectives, in 1983, the 1st Convention and Symposia was held in Veterinary College, Bangalore; which, since 1986, now has become a regular feature and a grand annual colloquium. Depending on the animal healthcare priorities, every annual symposium has a theme to reflect current research, evaluate progress and adoption of healthcare strategies. It thus becomes an opportunity to learn, retrospect and deliberate for all those who partake in the congress. The learned men share their thoughts and ideas, which are later collated and compiled as salient recommendations to be forwarded to Government agencies for incorporation and acceptance as decisive policy programmes. In this Golden Jubilee year, SKUAST-Jammu was chosen as the venue to host this year's memorable Congress. Coincidentally, Dr B.N. Tripathi, Vice-Chancellor of SKUAST-Jammu and Conference Chair of the Congress, is also the incumbent President of IAVP who shall supervise and steer this momentous event.

### Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists

The Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists (ICVP) was established in 2008 under the aegis of

Indian Society for Certification of Veterinary Pathologist with its head quarter at IVRI Izatnagar, as an independent certification body for individual's professional accreditation in India. It aims for advancement in Veterinary Pathology by establishing the standards of training, practice and experience. The College was pioneered, conceived and developed by a group of 22 Life Members of IAVP having recognizable stature in academia, research, Industry and practice identified as Charter Members. As on today it has 84 Certified Pathologists called as Diplomat ICVP spread all over India. ICVP have more than 100 trainees enrolled under the mentorship of Diplomats and Charter members of ICVP ([www.icvp.in](http://www.icvp.in)).

### About Jammu

The city of Jammu is situated on the banks of the river Tawi, and surrounded by the Shivalik hills of the Himalayas to its North, East and South-East; Trikuta hills on the North-West; and Northern plains in the South. It was founded by the Rajput King Jambulochan in the 14<sup>th</sup> century. The region features a humid sub-tropical climate with extreme highs in summer and cooler winters. Month of November is cool and pleasant with temperature average of 16.4°C (Min. 9.6°C - Max. 23.8°C). Winter clothing may be required. Jammu is well connected to other parts of India through air, rail as well as inter-state bus services. SKUAST-Jammu at Chatha campus is ~6.4 km from Jammu Civil Airport, Satwari, Jammu, ~12.3 km from Jammu Tawi Railway Station, Trikuta Nagar, Jammu, and ~12.0 km from General Bus Stand, Resham Ghar Colony, Jammu.

### Places to Visit

Jammu is famously called the 'City of Temples'. Vaishno Devi Temple being one of the holiest Hindu pilgrimage sites is located in Katra on Trikuta Hills (~60 kms from Jammu). Other important places of interest are- Raghunath Temple, Bahu Fort & Gardens, Amar Mahal Palace, Mubarak Mandi, Mansar Lake and Suchetgarh-Pakistan International Border.

Srinagar in the valley of Kashmir is approximately 250 kms from Jammu and connected by air and road. Average November temperature is expected to be very cold, about 7.8°C (Min. 2.7°C-13.7°C).
